A. Local League Report

<u>D. Reeves,</u> <u>Vice President Local League Operations</u>

This year TNT fielded 5 teams in the local league circuit (Two bantam teams and three midget teams). Each of the teams played a 26 game schedule, then were seeded for the playoffs. The teams fared reasonably well during the regular season, but exploded in the playoffs. When it was all said and done, we ended up with two divisional championships, two finalist positions, and were playing until the end of March.

Congratulations to the coaches and bench staffs who took the teams into the playoffs. This year, Simcoe Region tried a pilot project. There were 21 local league teams registered in the bantam division. By the team they had each played 12 games, the division was re seeded. Teams then played the rest of the season against teams of their own caliber. For our TNT Bantam teams, this meant a more competitive end to the season. The trial was successful by all counts, and may be expanded next year into other divisions where there are a large number of teams registered.

There has been considerable talk about a new league forming (Called North of 89). The founders of the league were claiming that TNT and other centers were members of the new loop. For us, this would have tripled our driving times to get to the centers to play our games. Our Board passed a resolution in February not to be associated with this new league, so we will continue our membership in the Simcoe Region Local League. Joining us will be Thornton, Lefroy, Bradford, Schomberg, Beeton, Nobleking, and Richmond Hill. ~DR

B. 2018 Mite/IP/Tyke Reports

Our season started last May, a group of coaches from the previous season started meeting to share back and make changes to the previous program. We decided to form a committee that would meet regularly to set up and give feedback to the board on changes and improvements. Our ultimate goal - to make our IP program one the best in York Simcoe.

The committee's first actions were getting the board to approve funding for the half boards and smaller nets.

Mite-

Joel was our lead coach and developed all of the practice plans. Joel was very fortunate to have 6 to 7 on ice helpers on any given practice. Our on-ice helpers, helped up have a nice 4-1 coach ratio most weeks. The program was very successful and it concluded with the playing of a half ice game during our final weekend

IP-

This was the first year of our IP program. The league consisted of 6 teams, 74 players aged 5 and 6. The coaches experimented with a few different practice plans and configurations of teams on the ice during practice. We decided that the best format for practices was to have two teams on the ice and to have shared practice plans. Each coach shared, took turns making the plans for the week and all teams followed the plans. This was a very successful part of our program and we found that all coaches worked together and teams seemed to develop at the same level.

Games were fun, big change from last year. We implemented short shifts (1:30 buzzers) and we played cross ice using the blueline area for benches. This gave our IP players the chance to get more puck touches and score more goals, the short shifts keep them engaged.

We hope to continue team coaching next year and are looking at having the committee write a 18-20 program that will be phased into four sections- Assess-Learn-Develop-Compete. This program will replace weekly practice plans and ensure that players are being developed at an appropriate level and that all players are receiving the same content.

Tyke-

Tyke consisted of 4 teams 44 players in total. The Tyke teams played half-ice hockey. This was first year that we did not have Tyke MD or rep as this level. The games were fast paced and very competitive. The small nets and half boards added to the excitement. We did not have shared practices at this level and teams were responsible for their own practices and practice plans. The committee has decided that going forward that we will mandate the sharing of practice and practice plans. We want to ensure that all players at this level will be developing at the same level.

The year wrapped up with a successful year end Jamboree and we hope to continue this next year.
