



TNT Minor Hockey Player Evaluation Policies and Procedures

A - Eligibility

1. Any player/goalie may attend player evaluations (tryouts) for TNTMHA.
2. Players/Goalies must be in good standing.
3. Players/Goalies must register online and pay the fee before attending evaluations.
4. Players/Goalies may attend AA, A, or B evaluation/tryout skates. You do not have to attend AA or A first.
5. If a player/goalie wishes to attend evaluation/tryout skates in a higher age division, they must contact the VP of Rep Hockey, Chris Beusaert, to request permission.
6. The player/goalie must be top 3 to be eligible to make the team for the above age division.

B - Registration & Fees

1. Players/goalies must register online through the Hockey Canada Registry using a valid credit card, or sending an e-transfer to erintnttreasurer@rogers.com before attending evaluations. Only players/goalies registered and paid in full will be permitted on the ice. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. Each player/goalie is required to sign in at the registration table prior to tryouts located in the lobby at the NTRC.
3. Each player/goalie will be given a jersey that they will keep and wear throughout the entire tryout process.
4. If the player/goalie attends AA evaluation/tryouts and is released and would like to attend A evaluation/tryouts, the player/goalie must register and pay the fee for A evaluation/tryouts prior to attending. The player/goalie will keep the same jersey they wore during the AA evaluation/tryouts to the A and B evaluation/tryouts.
5. Registration will be open on April 2, 2025. This is for ALL evaluation skates, AA , A, B and MD.
6. All evaluation skates are in the spring, commencing April 12, 2025 for U8 MD and U9 MD and April 26 for U10-U18AA.
7. Evaluation/tryout Skates for A will commence the week of May 3, 2025.
8. Evaluation/tryout Skates for B will commence the week of May 10, 2025
9. There are no refunds on evaluation/tryout skates registration fees.

C - Eligibility to Play in a Higher Division

TNT has established a policy that any underage player wishing to play for a higher division team, must be deemed to be one of the top 3 players on the higher division team to be considered for said team. The VP of Rep Hockey, along with their evaluation committee and Team Head Coach, will determine whether or not an underage player meets the requirement.

D - Injured Players

If a current TNTMHA player becomes injured prior to or during the evaluation process, each situation will be dealt with individually. Players may be assigned to their same level for the next year, or they may

be reassigned to another team after input and consultation with coaches and convenors for that age group.

E - Other Important information

1. Where a division has 40 or more skaters in attendance at the first evaluation skate, the coach may eliminate players if they wish after the first evaluation.
2. All players are guaranteed 2 skates – except in the situation in point 1 above.
3. Where a division has 50 or more skaters in attendance, the evaluation skate will be split in half to 45 minutes per session. The player/goalie will be notified at the tryouts what session they will be attending.
4. Offers of Commitment can be offered after the first skate.
5. Representative players MUST register for the season upon acceptance of their offer. If any player does not register, their roster spot may be filled by another player.
6. Coaches may ask for a Team Start up fee – this fee is not to exceed \$300.
7. All players and goaltenders are expected to attend all evaluation skates (unless been dismissed). If an evaluation skate is going to be missed, the player/goaltender must contact the coach prior to the evaluation skate. Attending another centre's evaluation skates, outside tournaments etc are not viable reasons to miss evaluation skates for TNTMHA.
8. The TNT Board of Directors reserves the right to make judgments on exceptional circumstances in respect to any section of this policy.
